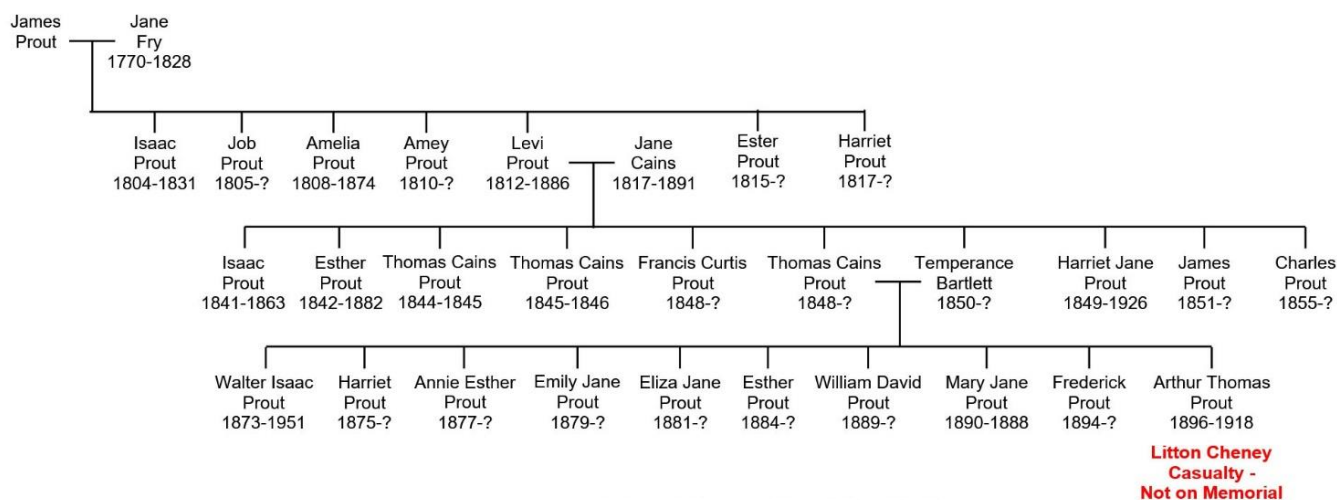


## Charles Henry James Burt – Family History
