- Basketball surface to be cleaned
- and most important, the damage to the grass done by Mr Mole; this needs levelling.

The Parish Council could pay someone to do this work but, like the Premier Crew, it would be good to have members of the village, especially those whose families perhaps are likely to take advantage of what is a popular resource, form a group (the more the merrier of course) to work their way through these maintenance tasks – this cannot be left to one or two people.
