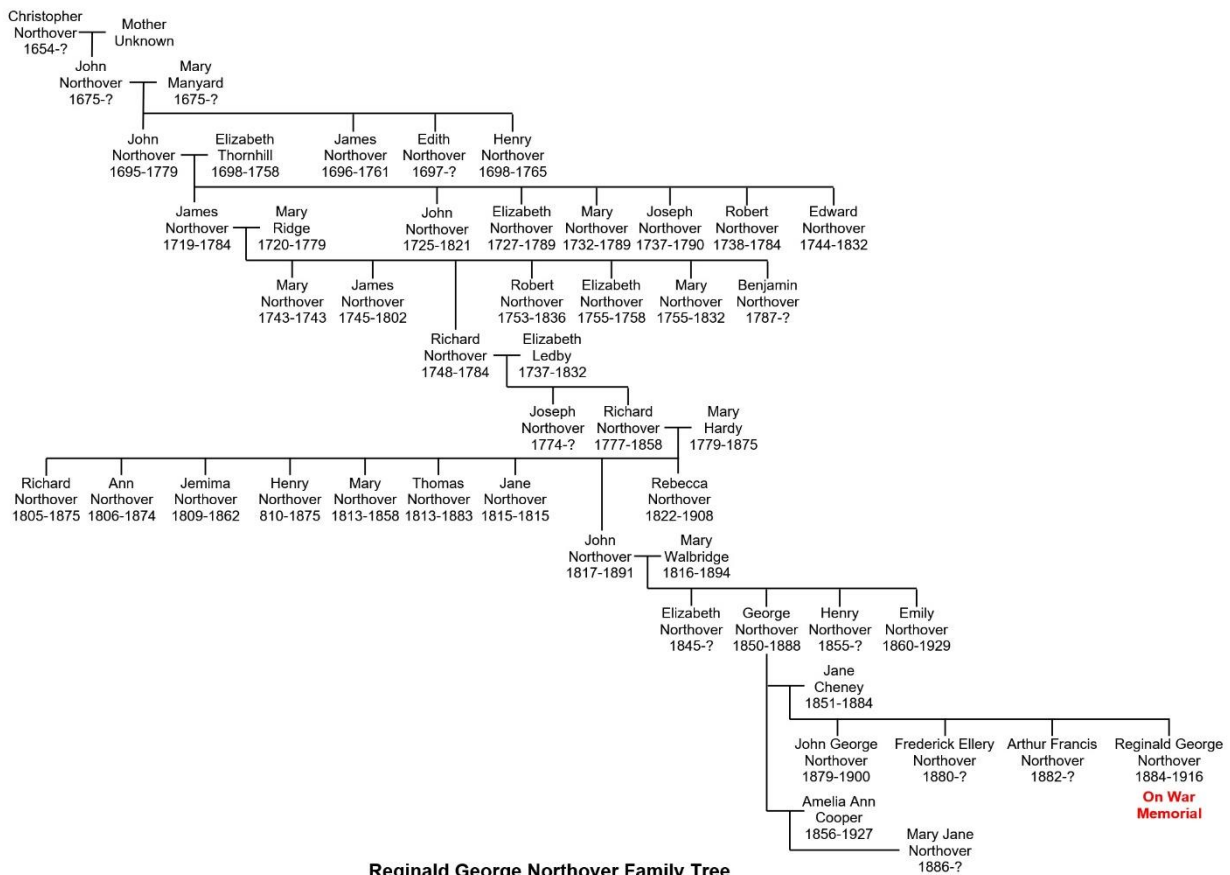


## Reginald George Northover - Family History

Jane Northover died in 1884. George then married Amelia Trowbridge on the 29<sup>th</sup> of January 1885. George died in January 1888 whereupon Amelia became head of the household.

### 1901 Census

Reginald enlisted on the 24<sup>th</sup> of October 1904 for 12 years. Height 5 feet 4 inches, brown hair, grey eyes, fresh complexion. Postman prior to enlisting.

Stoker 1st Class on HMS Queen Mary. Service No. 307832

He died on the 31<sup>st</sup> of May 1916 at the Battle of Jutland. Body not recovered for burial.
