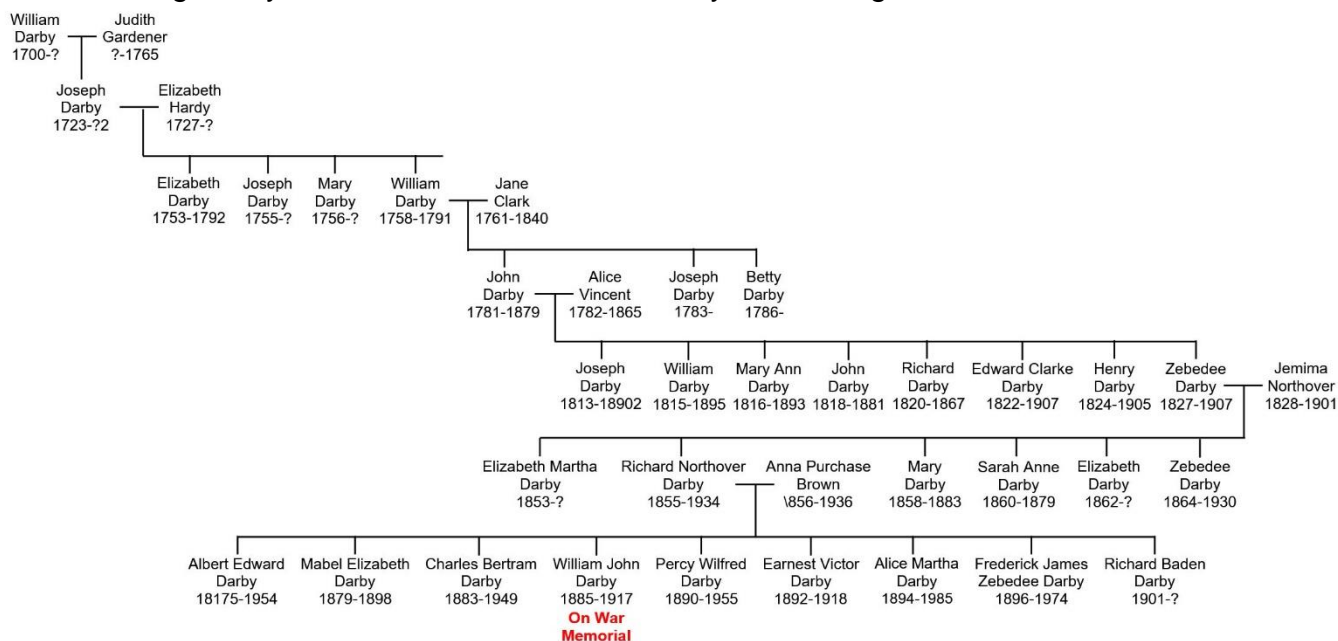


William John Darby – Family Tree

During the war he was a Lance Corporal in the Royal Marine Artillery. Service No. PLY/4689
 He died on the 5th of April 1917 on SS Calliope after she was torpedoed by the German submarine U-65 (Hermann von Fischel)
 Buried in Trapani Town Cemetery, Italy, plot I, row 4A.
